We remain committed to the future of CSM and the delivery of a vibrant place to live, work, and visit. Following last year's challenges with rising construction costs and evolving regulations, we are now embarking on a new vision for the site.

JTP Architects has been appointed on behalf of Telford Living to develop a new vision masterplan for the comprehensive redevelopment of Chrisp Street and to prepare a new planning application for a residential-led, mixed-use scheme. Our goal is to submit the planning application to Tower Hamlets Council early next year.

Subject to obtaining planning permission, Telford Living will be able to embark on the next stage of the redevelopment of Chrisp Street, bringing the vision to life over the coming years.

After navigating last year's uncertainty, we're pleased to reconnect actively with the local community. Your thoughts and ideas matter greatly to us, and we warmly encourage your involvement in shaping a sustainable, successful, and enjoyable place for future generations.

LANSBURY WARD

Good news! The Met Police have reported that crime levels in Lansbury Ward have dropped across all categories year on year - except for drug use, which has increased by 4%.

As a result, tackling drug-related crime remains one of the top three priorities for local officers. Efforts include dealer arrests, vehicle seizures, and exclusion orders for drug users and rough sleepers involved in crime.

Current Priorities

- Tackling drug dealing related activity within specific areas and green spaces.
- ✓ Focus on violent crime around Chrisp Street.
- Reducing burglary and night time ASB around Chrisp Street Market and surrounding areas. The situation has improved significantly, but it remains a key focus.
- Creating better information points and communications through non digital channels to ensure inclusivity for non app / non digital residents.
